which amounts to \$1,332 per person, regardless of age



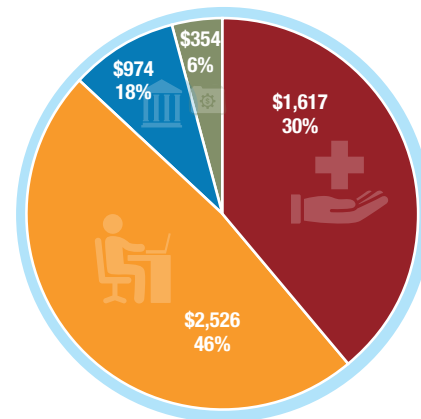
Compared to \$38.4 billion or \$1,081 per person in Canada

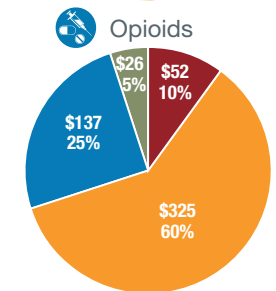
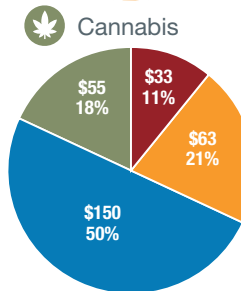
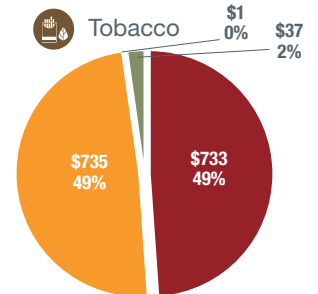
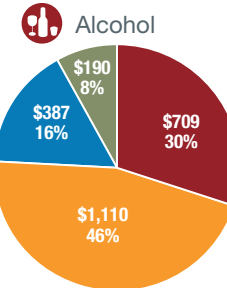
Costs of substance use by cost category in 2014 (in millions)

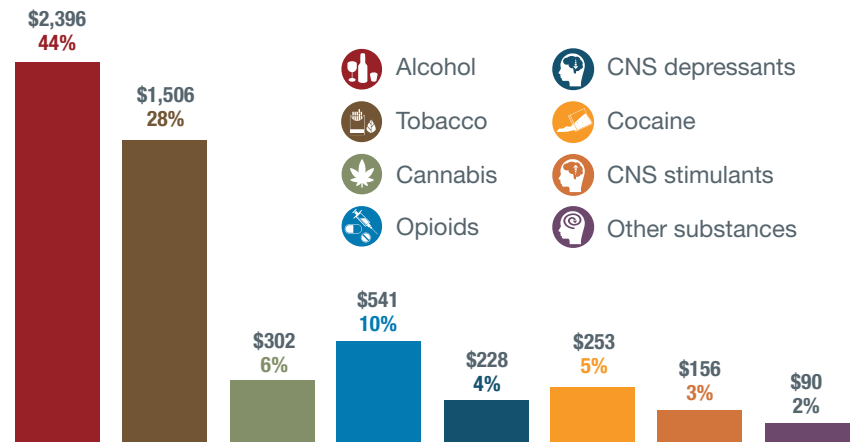

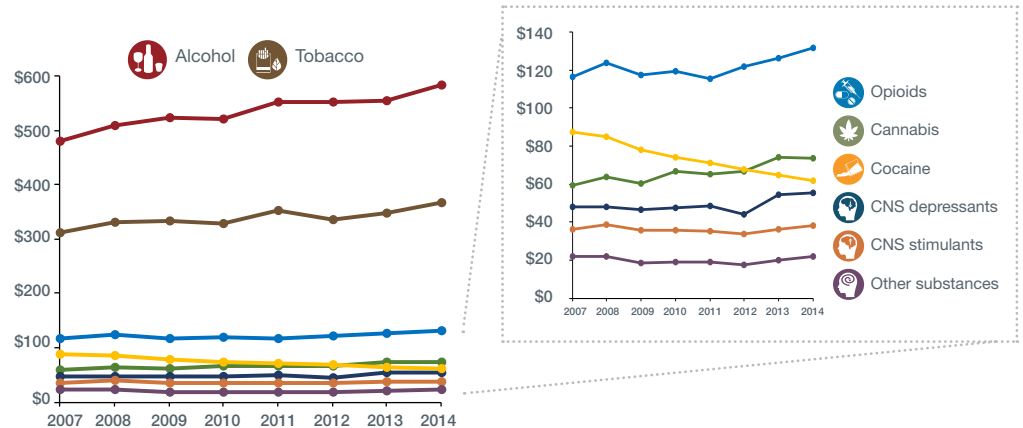
Top 4 substances:
