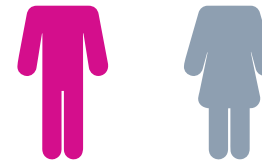

are accessing treatment

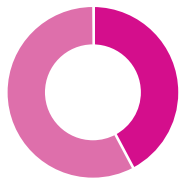

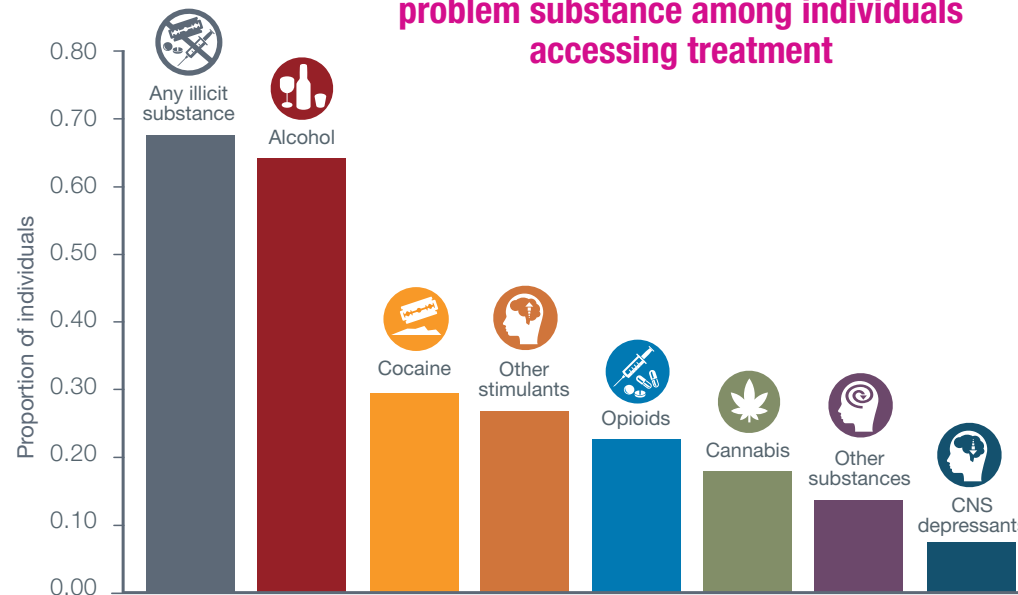
